




Lentinus tuberregium

Figures 2-5 show early stages in development of a fruiting body and the numbers under the drawings are dates. Figures 6-8 show later stages. David Pegler (*The Genus Lentinus*, HMSO, 1983) notes that the fungus "initially infects dead, decaying wood, such as fallen tree trunks, producing a sclerotium which eventually falls to the ground and becomes buried in the soil".
