BOTANIC GARDEN: DEVELOPMENT.

I refer to the Assistant Secretary's comment on proposals for the development of the Botanic Garden, and pending the submission of a fuller report on the proposals it is requested that an area of about 5 acres be made available at the eastern end of Lake McKenzie so that planting of that material available at Yarralumla Nursery and intimately connected with the tree breeding and Botanic Garden programme can be established in a frostfree area at Jervis Bay for use during the next few years.

If the plants are not established this winter they will be lost.

The area is in Block 21, Jervis Bay, held under quarterly lease by Mr.T. N. Ellmoos, and it is felt that the disturbance bo the present tenant would be negligible.
